

Ephemeral to Enduring:

The Role of Archival Software in a Digital World



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Consider This...



The purpose of the web:

- "ephemerality is built into the very architecture of the web" (LaFrance, 2015).
- "Time is working against the archivists. Internet content is ephemeral and even material in libraries is fragile and disappearing" (Knutson, 2009).

Digital Life Span

- On average, a webpage will only last 100 days
- Digital data (even backups) disappear quickly.

Link or Reference Rot

 "Nearly half of all Supreme Court decisions up to [2013] and more than 70 percent of law journals from 1999 to 2012 referred to Web pages that no longer existed"

Lack of Preservation

- The Library of Alexandria was destroyed -- "and not by technology, or a lack of it, but by people" (LaFrance, 2015).
- "Information in digital form—the evidence of the world we live in—is more fragile than the fragments of papyrus found buried with the Pharaohs" (Hamid, 1998).
- "Preservation requires...actively managing data at intervals, as opposed to just storing and ignoring it" (Venkataraman, 2015).

The purpose or role of Archives:

"Archival materials...serve as evidence against which individual and social memory can be tested. Archivists preserve such primary sources to enable us to better comprehend the past, understand the present, and prepare for the future" (Elia, 2015).



"Archivists face serious decisions, choices, and challenges as they consider which content, which media...will combine to constitute the historical record—a global time capsule of sorts—of yesterday and today" (Hamid, 1998)



I talked to Illien two days after the massacre in Paris at the offices of Charlie Hebdo. "We are overwhelmed, and scared, and even taking the subway is terrifying, and we are scared for our children," Illien said. "The library is a target." When we spoke, the suspects were still at large; hostages had been taken. Illien and his colleagues had started a Web archive about the massacre and the world's response. "Right now the media is full of it, but we know that most of that won't last," he said. "We wrote to our colleagues around the world and asked them to send us feeds to these URLs, to Web sites that were happening, right now, in Paris, so that we could collect them and historians will one day be able to see." He was very quiet. He said, "When something like that happens, you wonder what you can do from where you sit. Our job is memory" (Lepore, 2015).

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

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

Digital and Physical Archives

- We needed to find a way that we could consolidate all of our records
- We needed a program that could handle both the physical collections we have, as well as maintaining anything new that comes in in digital form


Accession Records and Finding Aids

- Currently we have no finding aids, and out Archives are not able to be searched by anyone except Archives staff
- We need software that will allow us to easily create finding aids, and help us make most our collections available to the public.

Hidden Collections

- Becoming recognized as a major problem for archives and special collections
- Researchers often must be physically present at special collections and archives to know what they hold

Possible Solution



Considerations when reviewing software for Archives:

- Are there collections to manage other than archival records?
- Which features do you need?
- How much customization will be required and how is it going to be done?
- Open source or proprietary software?
- How sustainable is the software?
- What kind of support is available?
- How much does the software cost?
- To what degree do you want to private public access to your collections?
- Do you want to automate the processing and description of collections?
- Is it hosted by a company or your local institution?
- Support for archival standards?
- Web-based vs. desktop client?
- Support for linking to digital objects?
- Reliability and Maturity

Decision Time

What software did we decide on?

- When we have the opportunity to implement, we will be going with Collective Access.
- If we have the ability at a later time, I would also like to adopt archival services through Archive-It.

Why I chose Collective Access

Acquisition Methods

The Edith Fitch Department of Archives accepts acquisitions of items and collections through the following methods:

- Internal transfer: the Edith Fitch Department of Archives will accept transfer of University records from departments wishing to donate.
- Donation: items and collections under consideration for donation to the Edith Fitch Department of Archives must comply with the acquisition criteria of the relevant collection category and be subject to the terms of a Burman University Donation Agreement.
- Loan: all incoming loans, once approved by the loaning institutions or persons, will be subject to the terms of the Burman University Loan Agreement.
- Purchase: records of exceptional value to the University may be purchased subject to the approval of the Edith Fitch Department of Archives and supervisors, and the availability of acquisition funds.

Subject Areas Collected


Alumni and Faculty History

 - c. Biographies
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
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

Activate or Deactivate a Single Seed

To activate or deactivate a single seed, click the Settings link for that seed. You will then see an Activation Status area where you can select to activate or deactivate the seed.

Activate or Deactivate Multiple Seeds

Select the check box to the left of each seed you would like to activate/deactivate. Then select the 'Bulk Edit' option and choose the action you would like (Activate or Deactivate).

Test Crawls

To run a test crawl, select the seeds you would like to crawl by checking the box next to the seed. You can review the seeds you have selected by clicking on the "Selected" tab. When you are ready to start your crawl press the 'Run Test Crawl'


